Q.1 How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

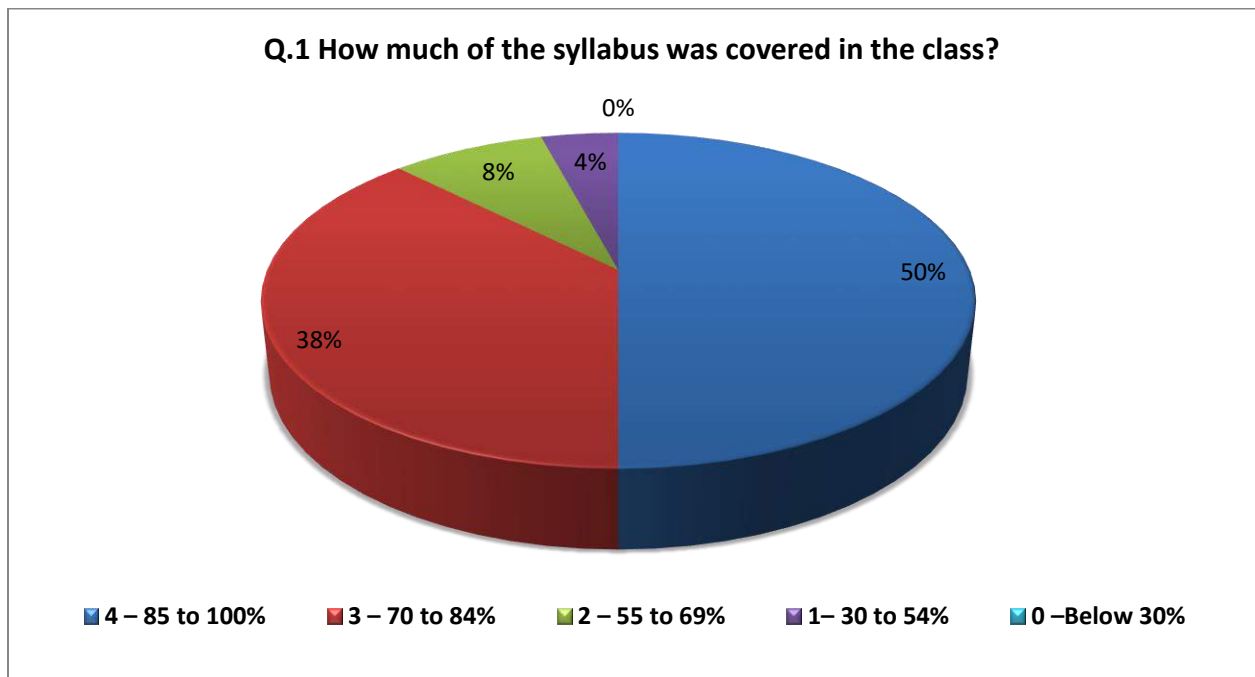

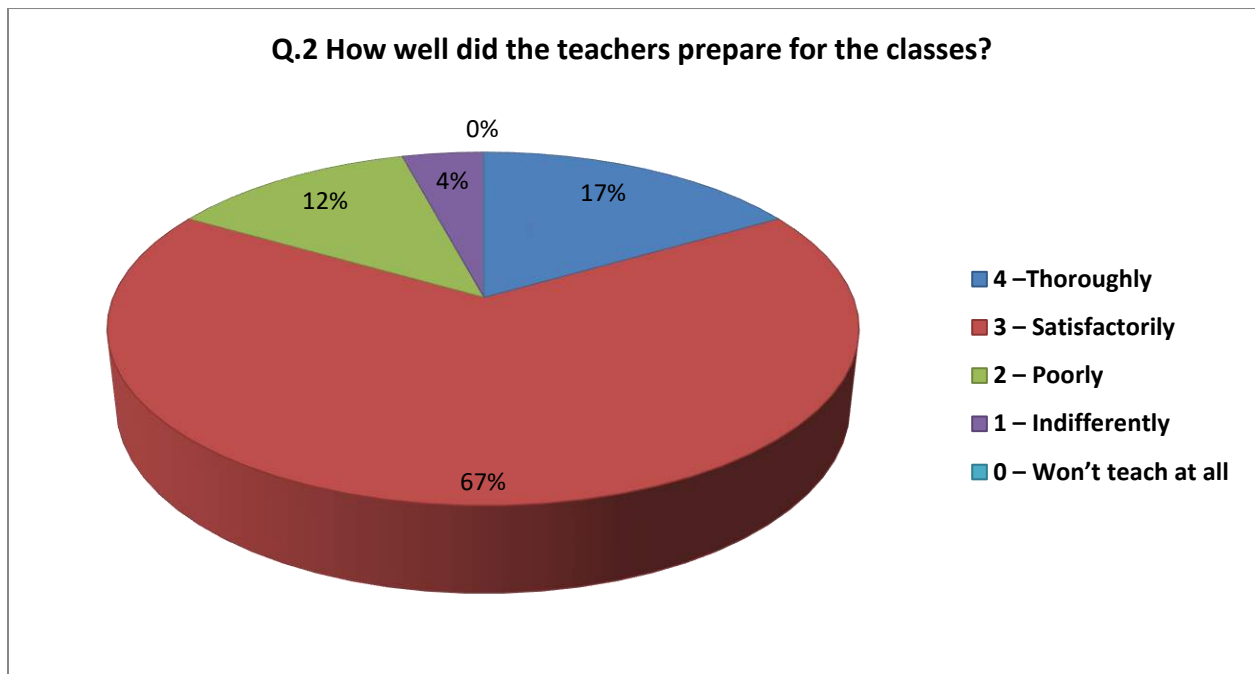

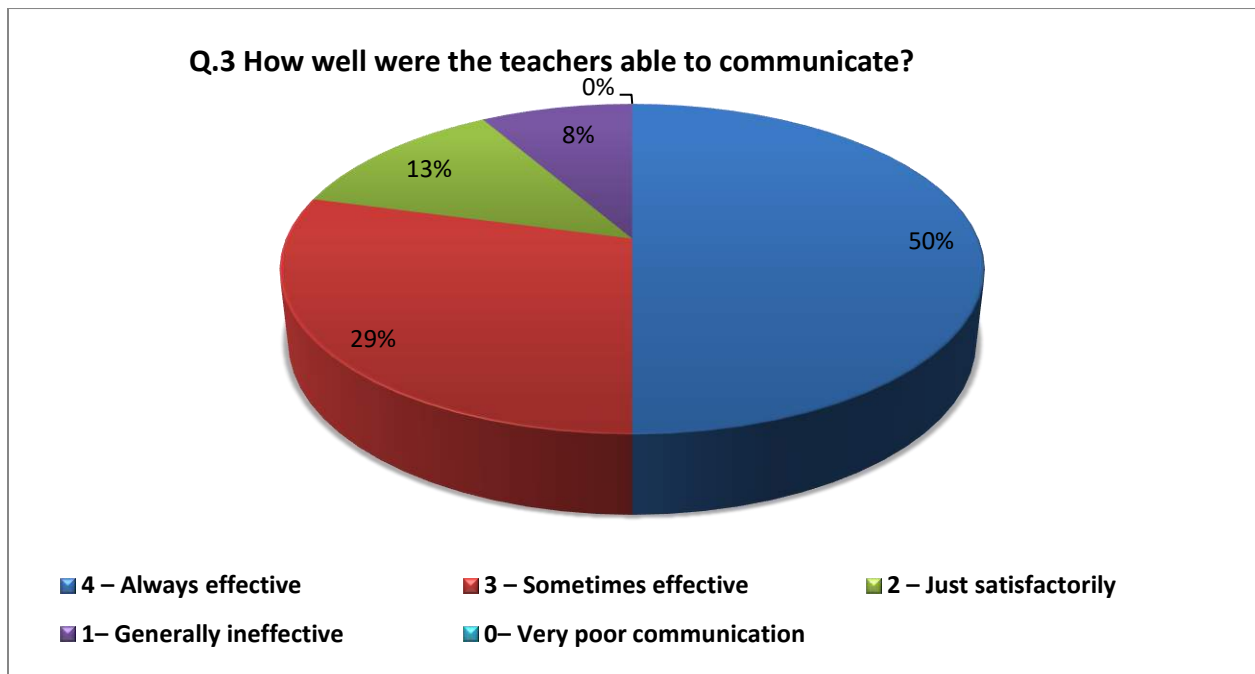

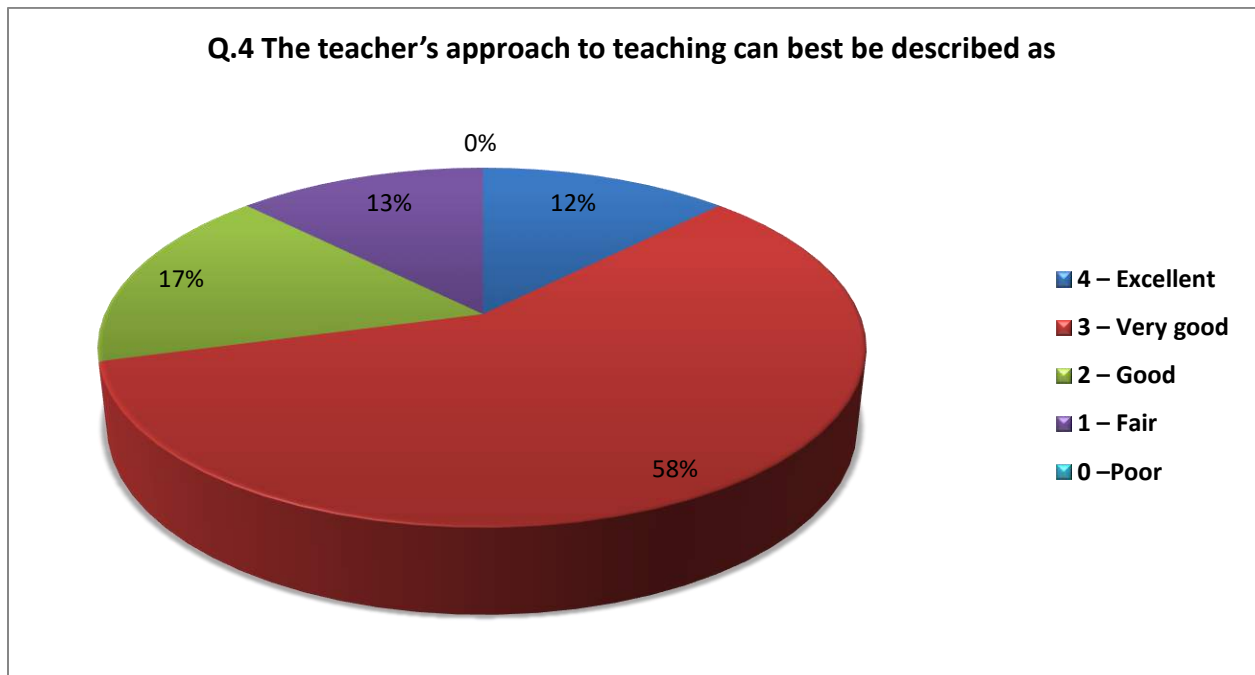

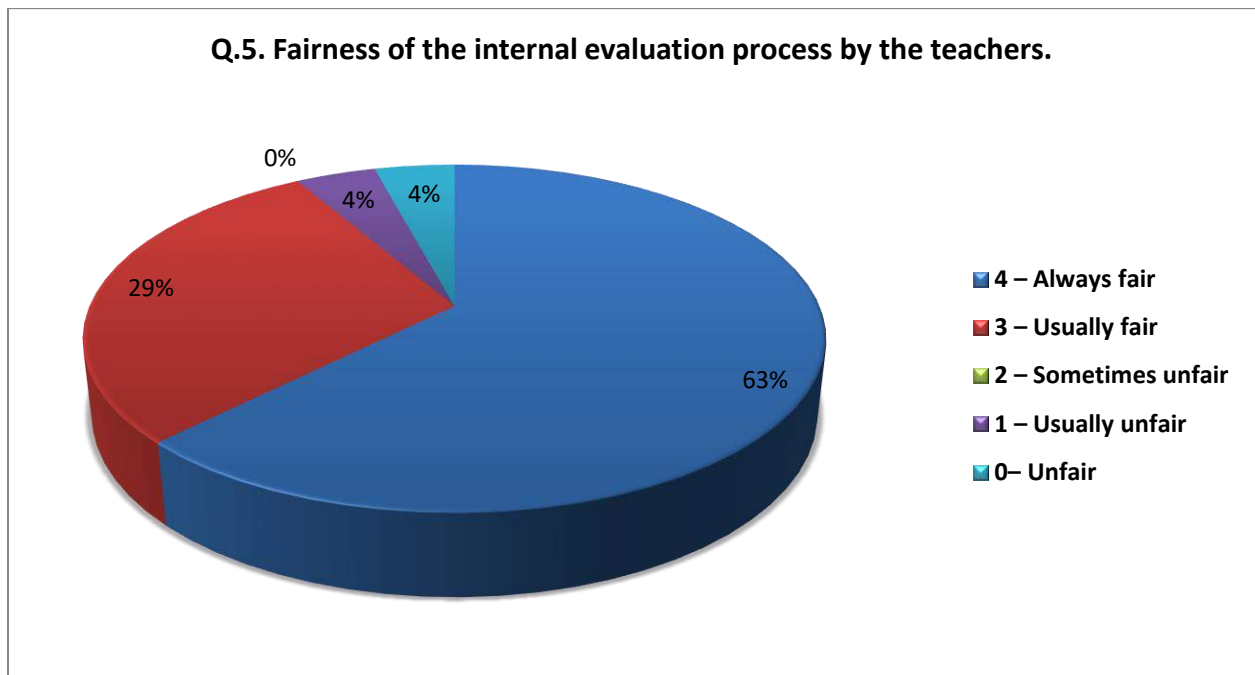

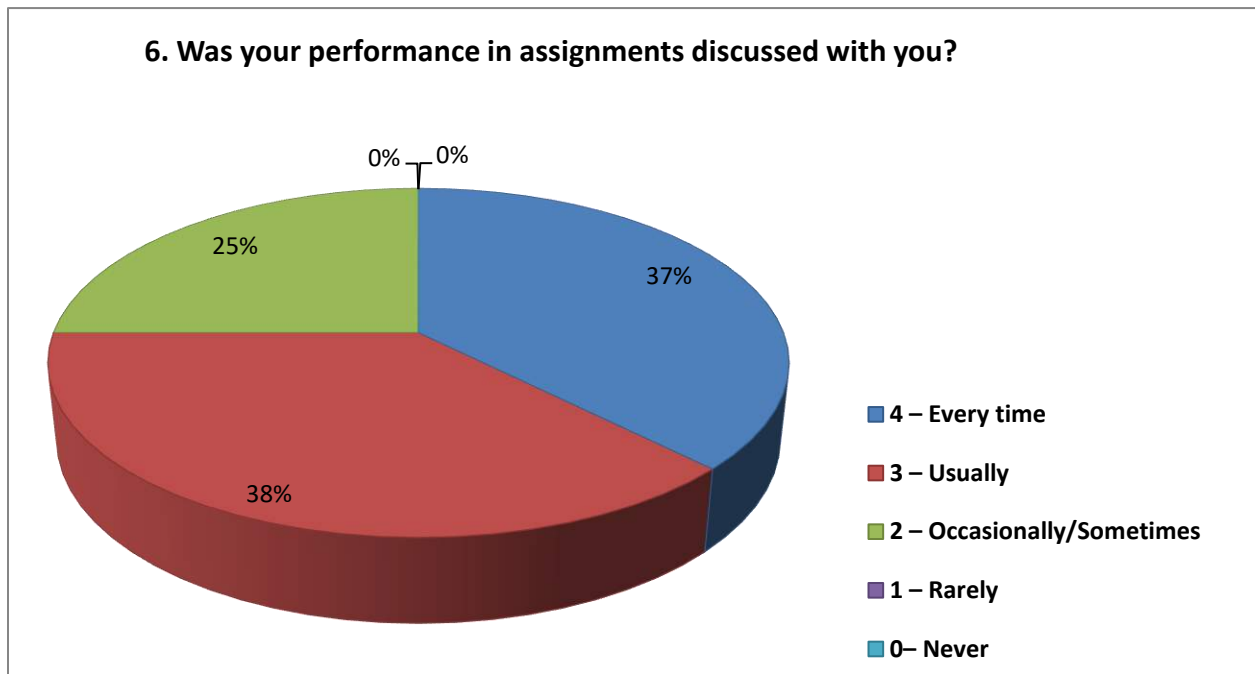

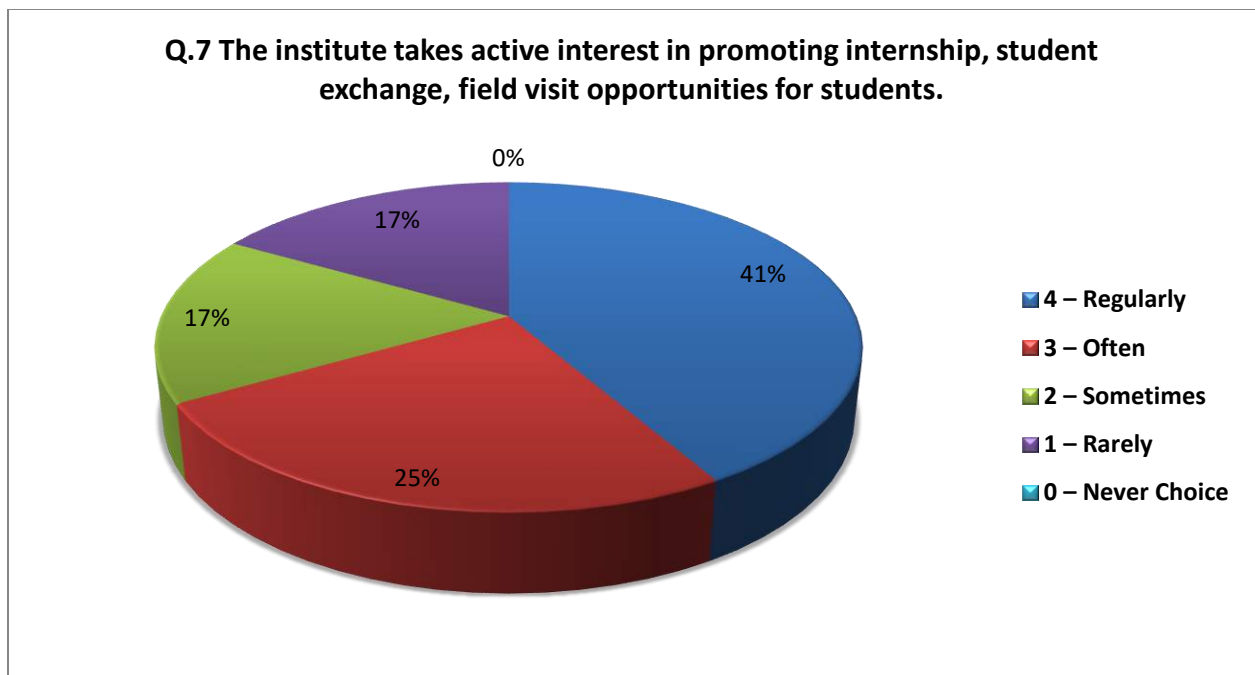

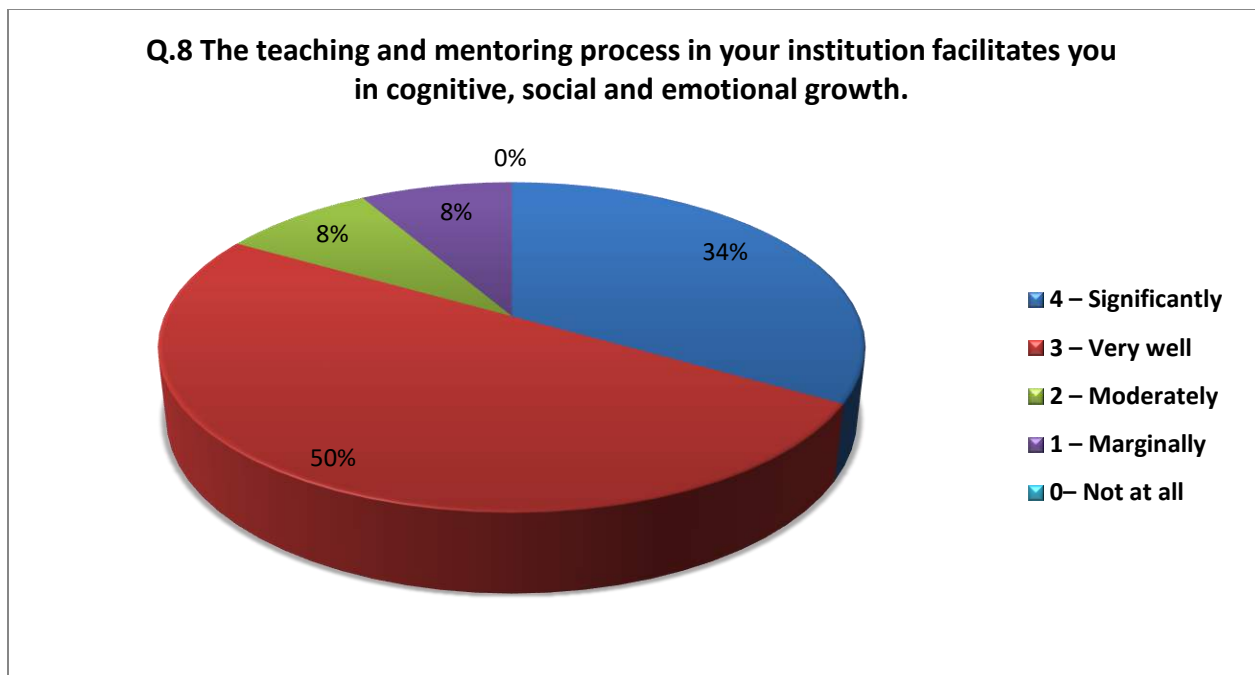

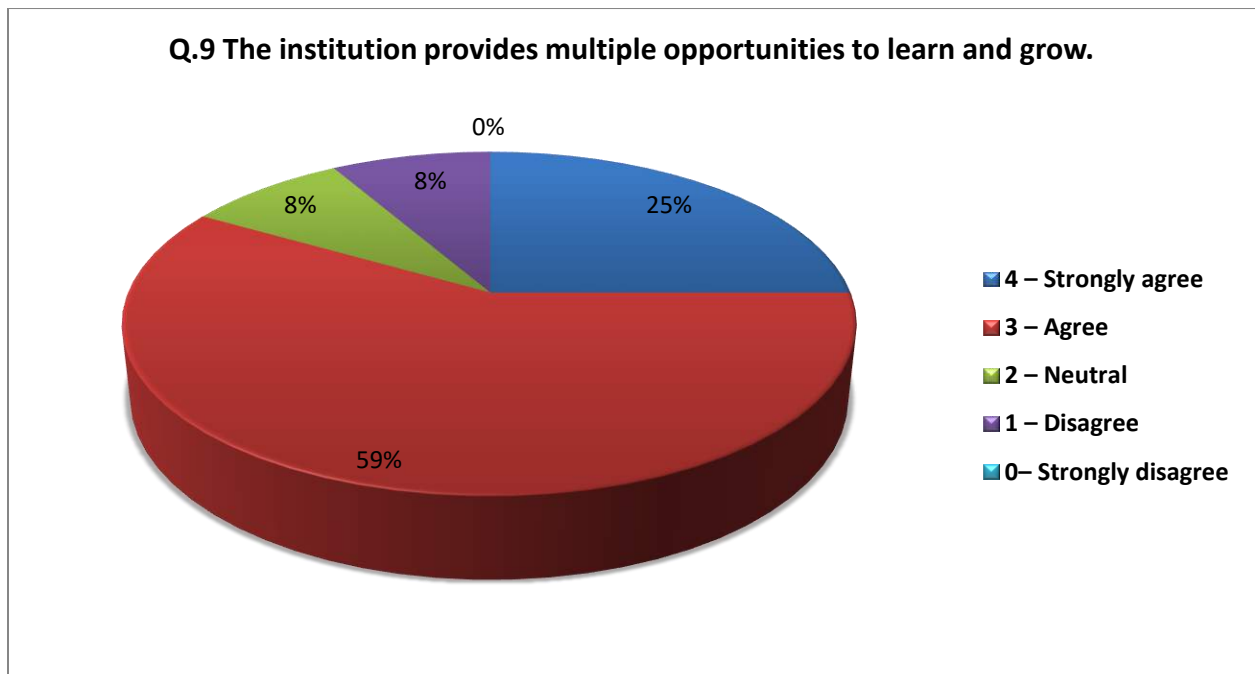

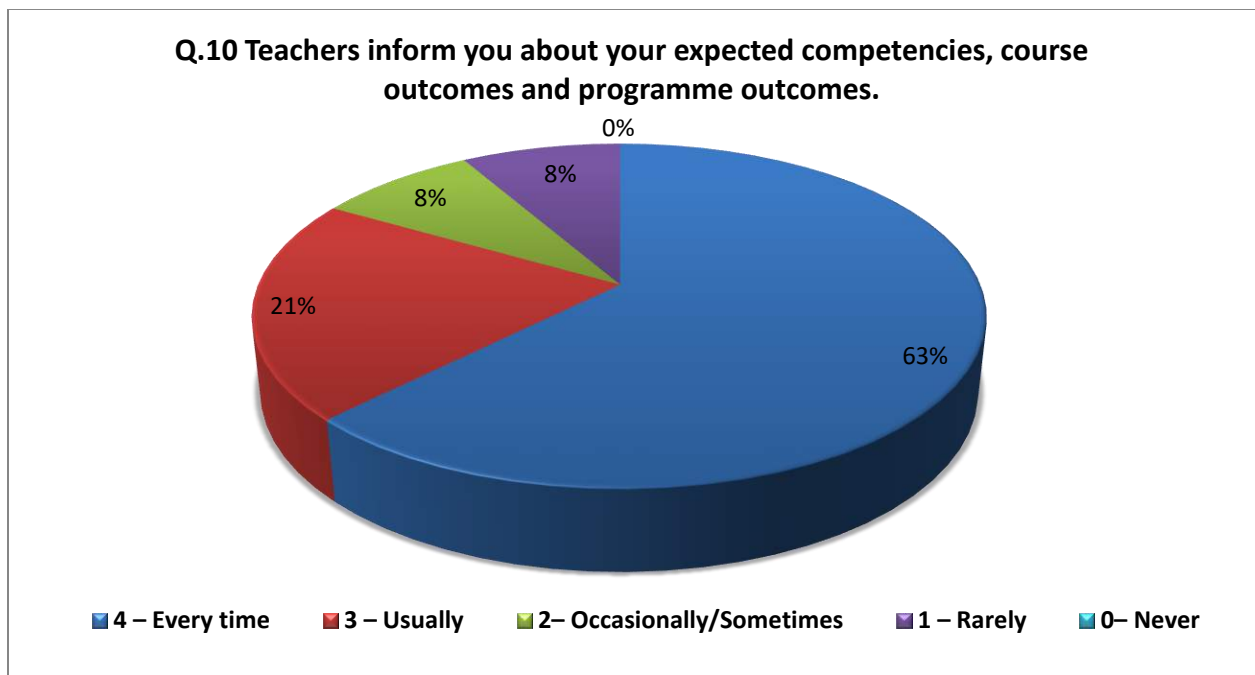

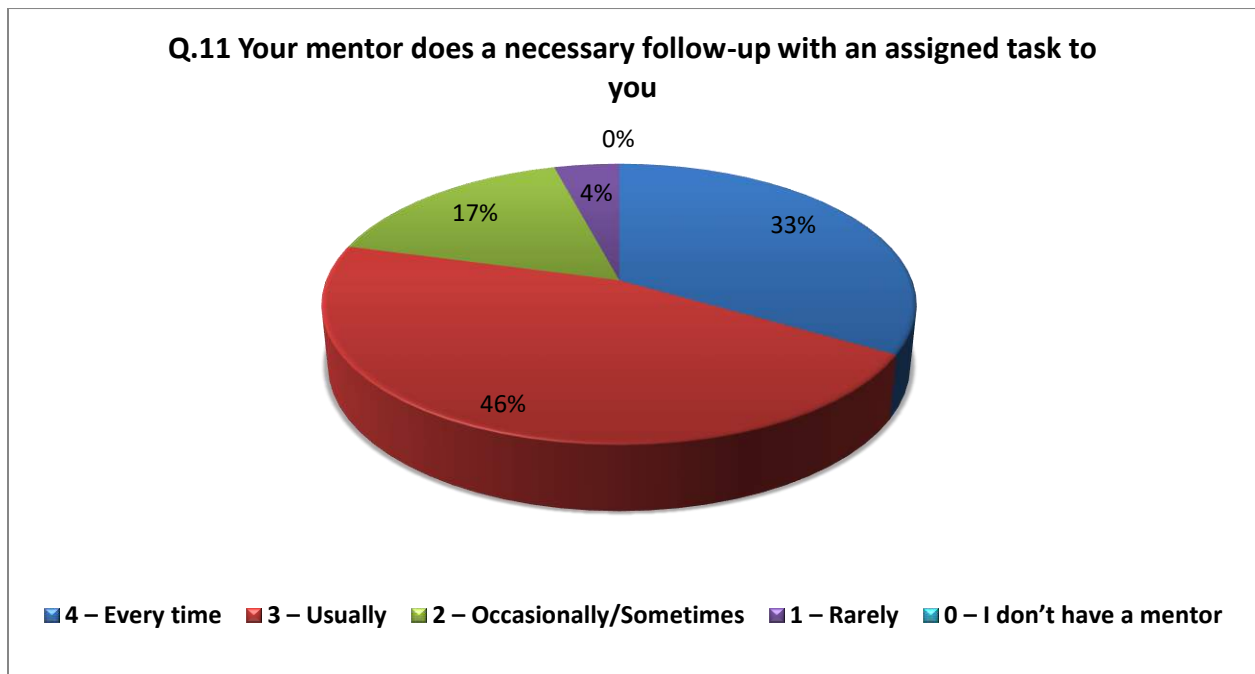

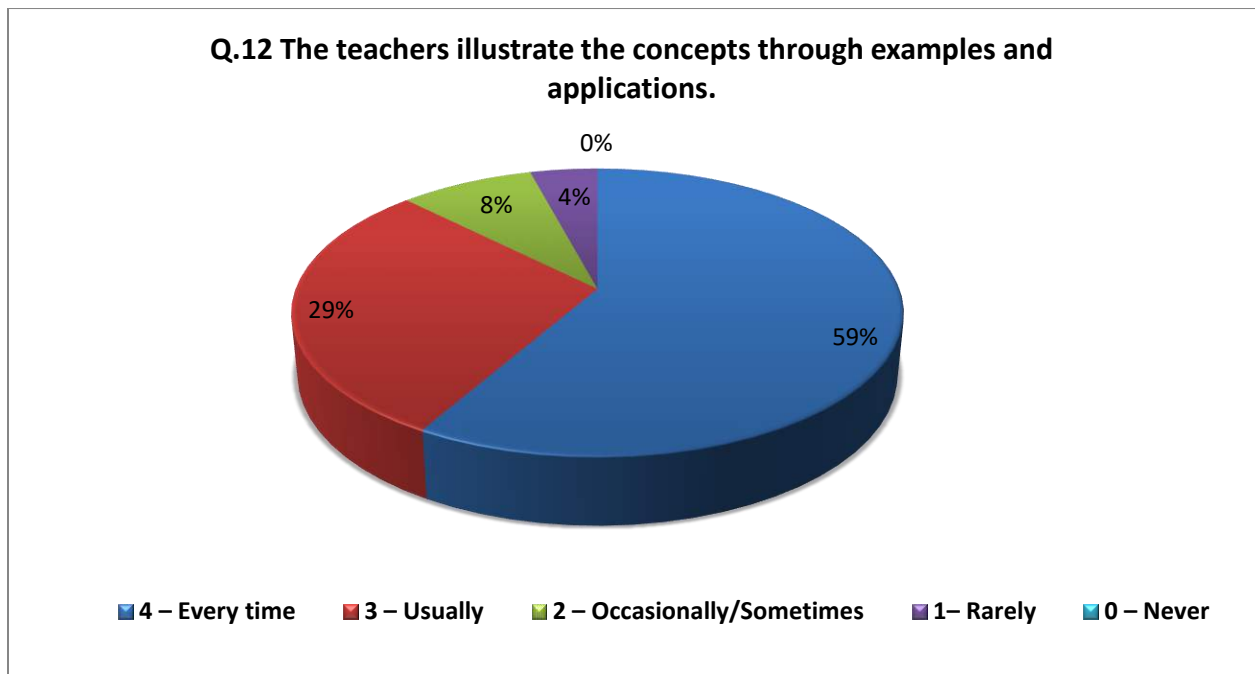

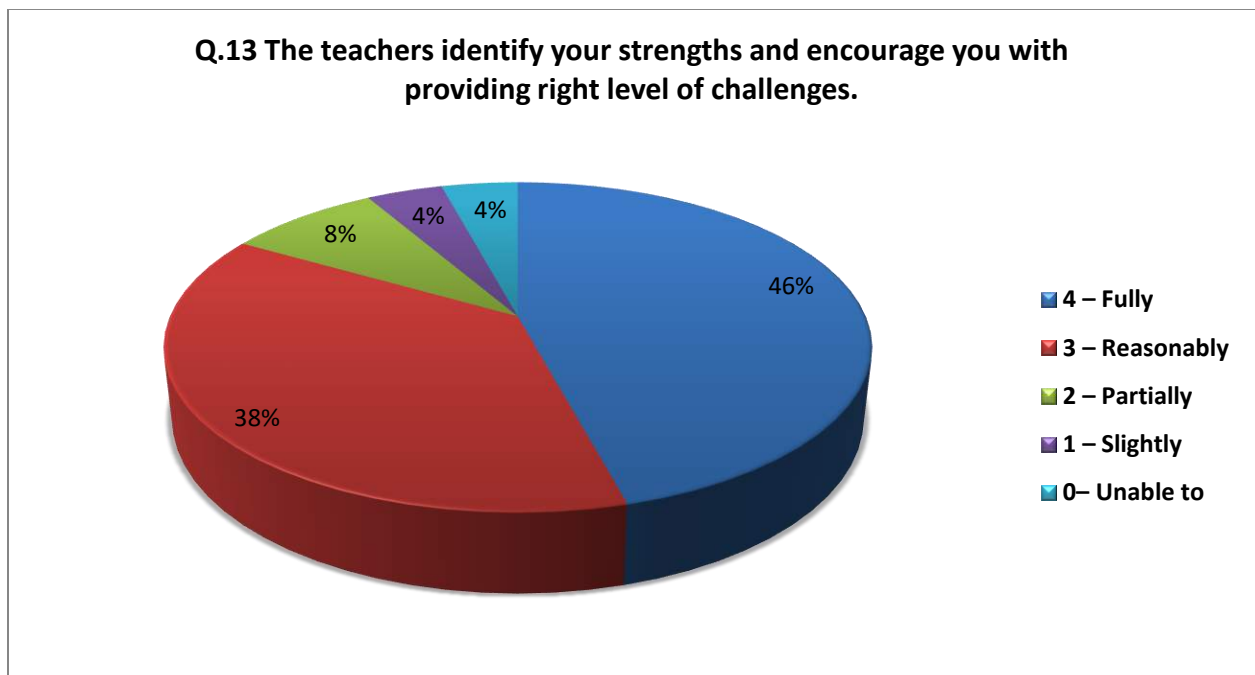

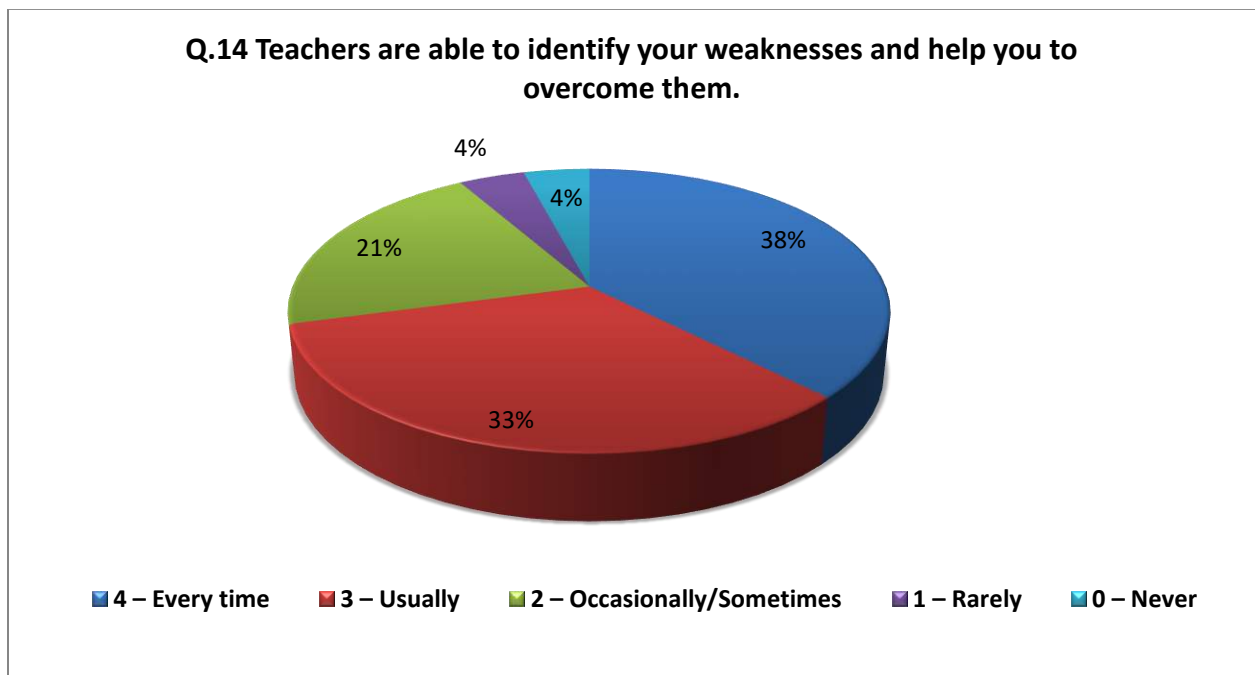

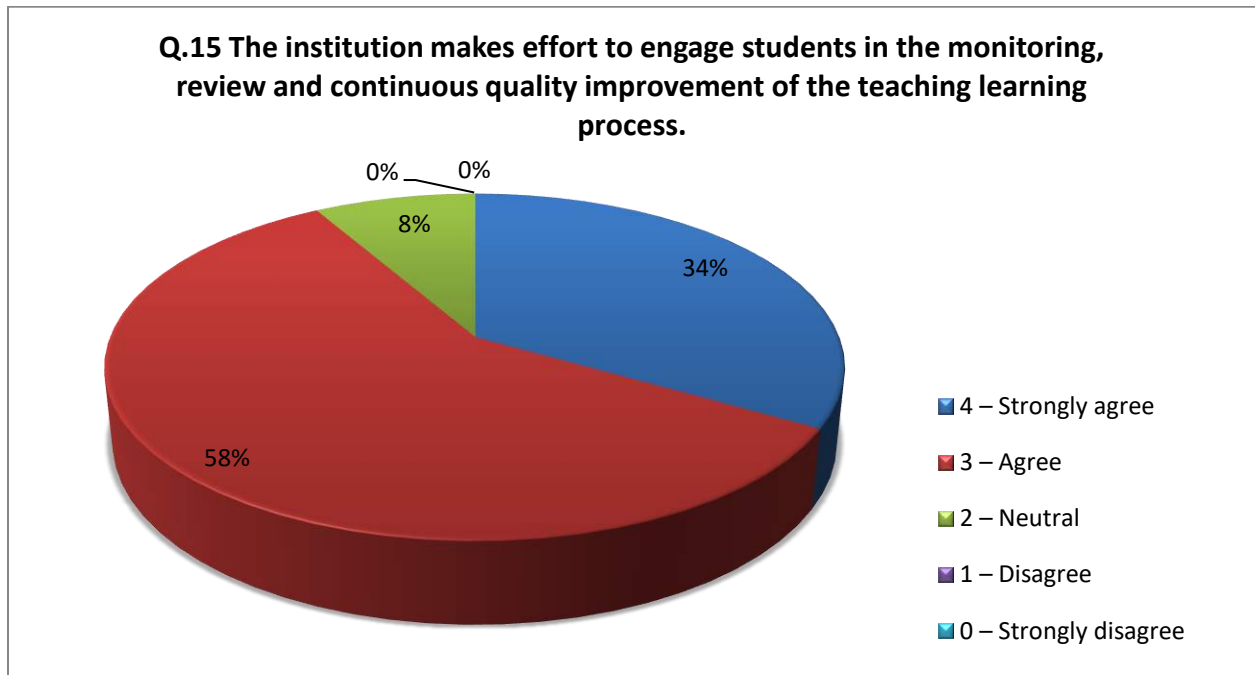

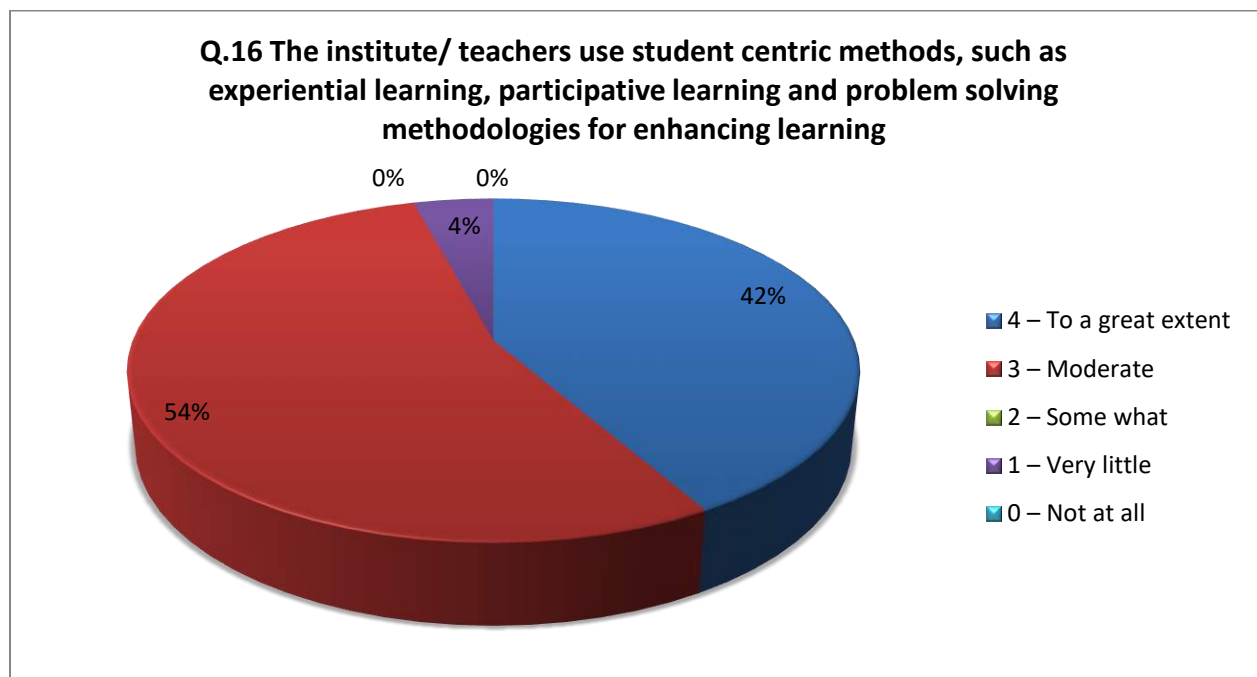

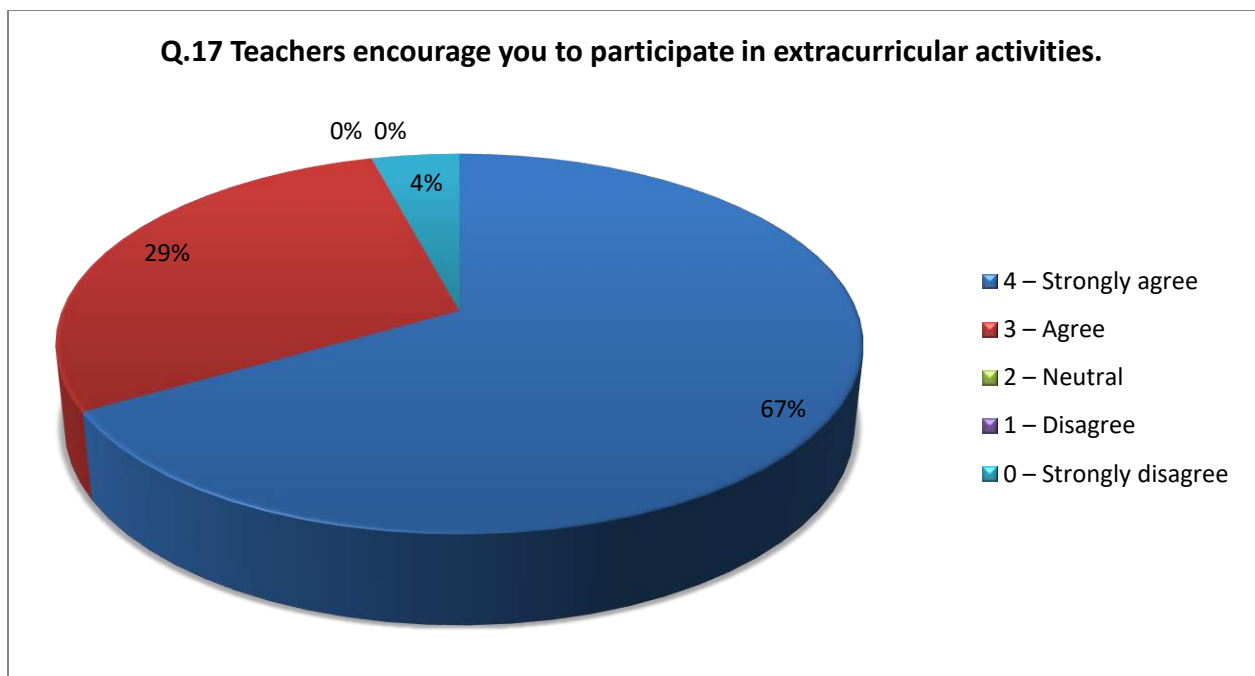

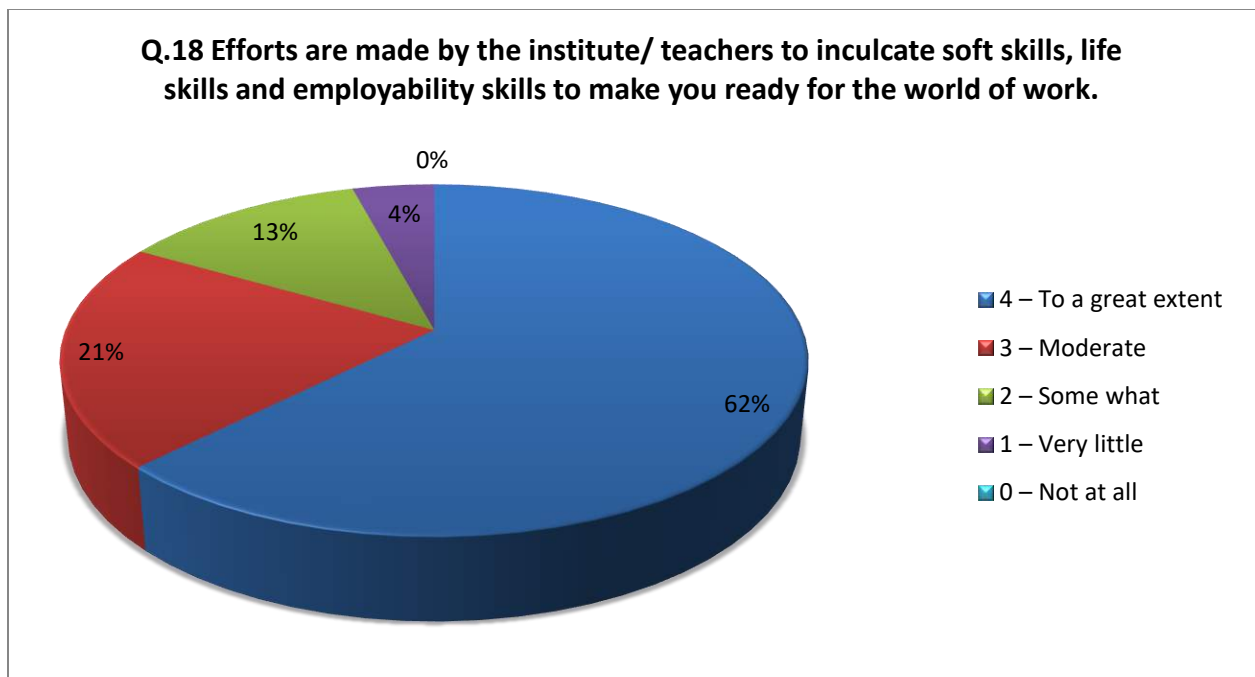

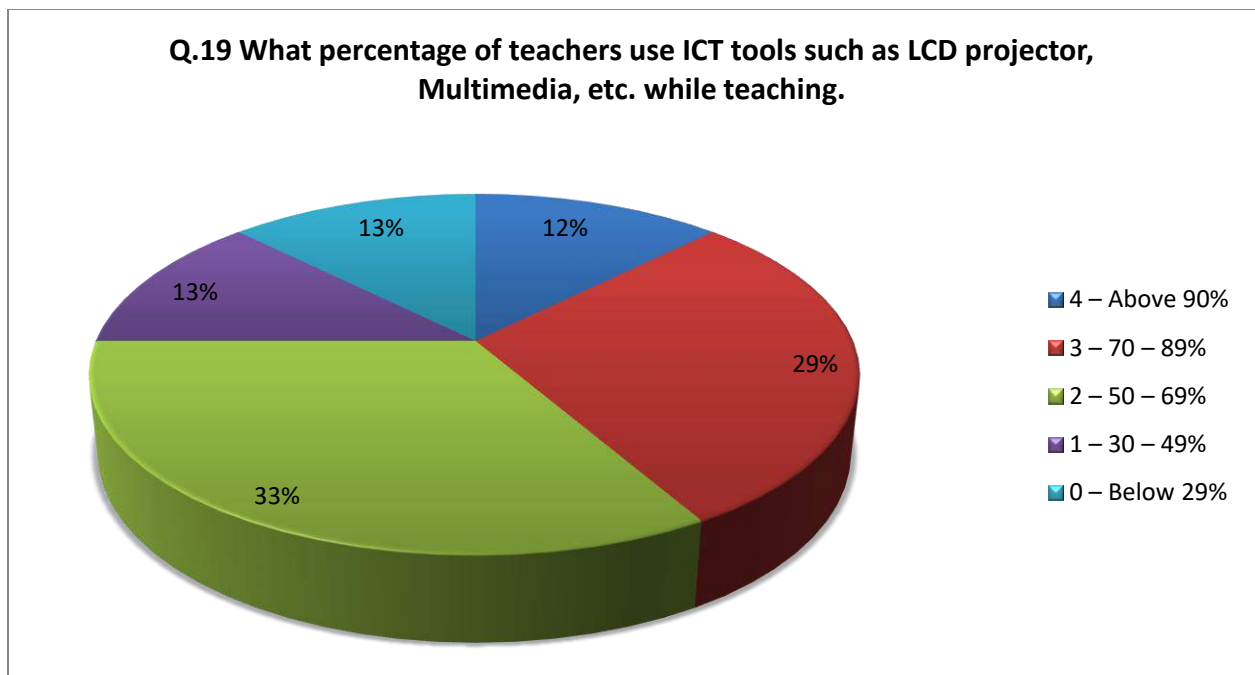

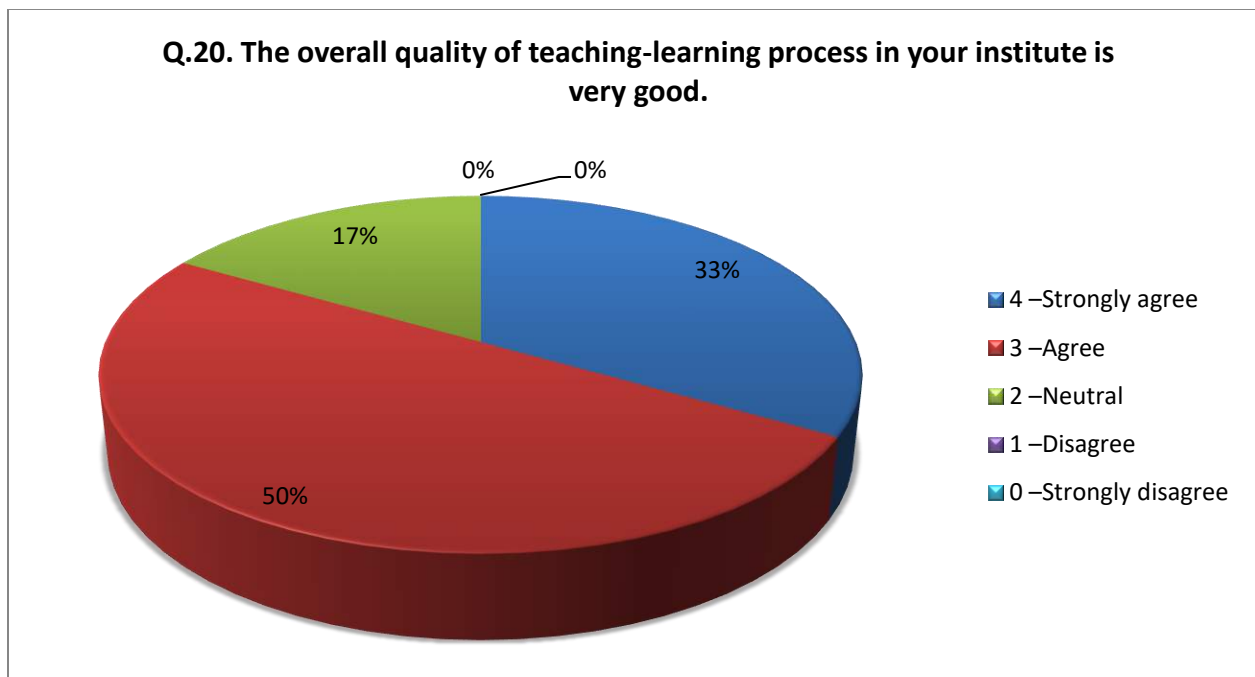
